WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR PRESENTATION

Deborah Cornavaca from the Office of the Governor presented on the state budget, COVID-19 updates and the Census.

UPDATES

PEI Kids shared that they utilized the CCYVC Playbook and was funded for a gang violence prevention program in the Trenton area to provide direct services to youth.

Isles is working towards providing antiracism services.

On behalf of Judy McPherson, Lori Johansson presented on creating a free after school program for Trenton children (elementary and middle school age) and their families that would be available at schools in their neighborhoods from 3-6pm. The program would be operated as a consortium, bringing together various existing organizations that have unique and different activities (eg soccer, music, mentoring, literacy, etc), strengths, themes, in order to create a holistic robust response to Trenton's broad health and wellbeing priorities that include resilience, prevention of violence, physical and psychosocial health, strengthening of education, culture and the arts, and community.
